- ❖ **Welcome sign-in**
- ❖ **Title IC Migrant PowerPoint** – Mike showed a PowerPoint presentation on where the district spends Title IC funds.
- ❖ **Graduation Date Change-** Voznesenka's 2015 graduation date has been moved from Thursday, May 28<sup>th</sup> to Tuesday, May 26<sup>th</sup> to accommodate the Cordova fishing opener.
- ❖ **Concerns from Mary Rainwater** – Mary Rainwater called the school to let us know several items from her cabin located by Voznesenka community are missing include some poker chips, a cd player with a radio and a splitting mall. We let her know we'd let the community know of her concerns.
- ❖ **Parent Wellness Survey** – The district is looking for feedback from parents. Title One/Migrant surveys were mailed home by the Migrant department and were made available to parents at the meeting. The online wellness survey link was shared with parents and was also included in the last issue of Cougar Comments. Parents were encouraged to provide feedback.
- ❖ **Office Changes** – Last week the secretary's office was moved into the workroom, the office is now a workroom. The community council approved both areas to be painted along with the principal's office. The room change will create more space and allow us to set-up a conference table in the secretary's office.
- ❖ **AMP Testing-** The State AMP tests will begin the week of March 30<sup>th</sup>. A copy of the AMP testing schedule for Voz was made available to parents. Parents were encouraged to book appointments that do not interfere with testing as testing attendance is counted towards the success of the school.
- ❖ **Lease Agreement for School** – The lease agreement for this school year has been signed. The 5 year lease agreement is up for renewal. A professional appraiser will be coming out to the school to determine what a fair lease price would be. Hopefully a new agreement will be signed soon.
- ❖ **Bids for Voznesenka Loop Road** – Bids for Voznesenka Loop Rd improvements are due to the Community Council by May 1<sup>st</sup>. Funding has been secured for the project. The hope is that improvements will bring the road up to borough standards. Tax assessments should not be incurred.
- ❖ **Open Position for Village Council** – The community council is looking to hire someone to work 12 hours per week. Salary will be based off of experience. The applicant will be required to attend community meetings, take notes, and keep meeting minutes and pay community bills. This will require the applicant to have basic computer skills in MS word and Excel. For more information on the job opening contact a member of the board or Stan White.
- ❖ **Schedule Parent Meeting for Football/Wrestling** – A meeting for all wrestling and football parents in scheduled afterschool on Wednesday, March 18<sup>th</sup>. In order for Voz teams to succeed we need parent and student commitment. Weight lifting is available to all male athletes from 4:15 to 5:15 at Justin Zank's shed. This option will be available throughout the summer.
- ❖ **Girls' Soccer** – Girls' soccer practice will start on Tuesday, March 10<sup>th</sup>. Practices will be held from Tuesday to Friday from 4pm till 6pm at McNeil Canyon School. Students are encouraged to carpool. All girls from grades 6-12 are welcome to participate. Only high school students will be traveling and competing. Soccer practice and game schedules were made available to parents and will be sent home with soccer players. Soccer uniforms have been ordered and have arrived. This year we are a Club Status sport and have four 90 minute games scheduled. For a full game we need eleven players. All
